- Invest in your team with meaningful conversations, professional development topics & content, and team-building activities.

THE MOST IMPORTANT EVENTS/MEETINGS TO HAVE TO GROW YOUR TEAM

There are countless meetings and events that you could have with your company to grow your team. Here are the most important ones that you need to schedule with your team:

- Once a week 20-minute "Stand Up" meetings Everyone, while standing, shares their
 most important priority of the week, and someone from leadership shares a leadership
 principle for the week.
- Once a month or quarterly "All Staff Meetings" 1/2 day or Full Day to get on the same page with Projects, Training Sessions, & Celebrate Goals
- Start of Year Team-building Do something that will kick the year off right.
- Mid-Year Celebration Realign everyone to the company vision & important goals.
- End-of-Year Party Bring everyone together to celebrate what was accomplished and thank them (and their significant other) for a great year.
- Retreat Take your leadership or full team somewhere to "retreat" before you move forward.
